

# VILLAGES OF STONELAKE ESTATES HOA

## POOL SAFETY RULES

**The use of the pool and amenity center is intended exclusively for the residents of Villages of Stonelake Estates and their guests. Do not open the gate for individuals who do not have a pool access card. Please advise them to call (972) 881-7488.**

### GENERAL

1. Pool hours are daily 7:00 am – 10:00 pm. Access cards will not work outside of posted hours. Anyone entering the pool or pool area outside of the pool hours of operation is trespassing and will be subject to arrest. Noise disturbances after these hours should be reported to the police.
2. All persons who swim and use the pool do so at their own risk. There is no lifeguard on duty.
3. The VOSE pool is to be used by residents and their guests (when accompanied by a resident) only. Residents must accompany all guests while in the pool area. A maximum of two (2) guests per household are permitted.
4. An adult must accompany children age 17 and younger.
5. All annual HOA dues and outstanding HOA violation fees must be paid in full, prior to use of the pool.
6. Pool entry cards for each family are required. Replacement cards must be purchased. Never loan your pool access card to anyone outside of your household.
7. Entry to the pool shall be through the front gate only. Climbing over the fence or gate is prohibited. The gates must remain closed and locked. Residents should not open the gates for others to enter and shall not be left propped open.
8. Do not stack furniture on top of each other or place any furniture in the pool.
9. Children who are not 100% potty trained are required to wear a swim diaper. No exceptions.
10. Animals are not permitted inside the pool area.
11. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the pool area.
12. Residents and guests must clean up after themselves and deposit all garbage in trash containers.
13. Non-swimmers and those wearing any type of life preserver/floatie must have a responsible swimmer providing direct supervision with them when in the pool and pool area.
14. Radios and speakers are only permitted if they do not disturb others.
15. The Homeowner's Association will not be responsible for any money or property loss sustained by members or their guests when using the pool.

## **CONDUCT AND HEALTH**

1. CAUTION: Water in the pool is shallow. NO DIVING ALLOWED. Running, pushing, tag games, "cannon balling", or rough housing of any kind are not permitted in the pool area.
2. Bicycles, roller skates, skateboards, scooters, motorized or battery-operated vehicles, unsafe equipment, and toys or activities that may result in accidents or injury are not allowed.
3. Everyone must leave the pool in the event of an emergency, including weather situations such as thunder and lightning storms.
4. Drug use, fighting, foul/abusive language, sexual assault or unruly conduct are not permitted.
5. Please do not visit the pool if anyone in your party is ill (colds, coughs, open sores, infections, nasal/ear discharge, etc.).
6. Use of floating tubes, rafts and toys must not interfere with the use of the pool by others. Use lifesaving equipment only in an emergency.
